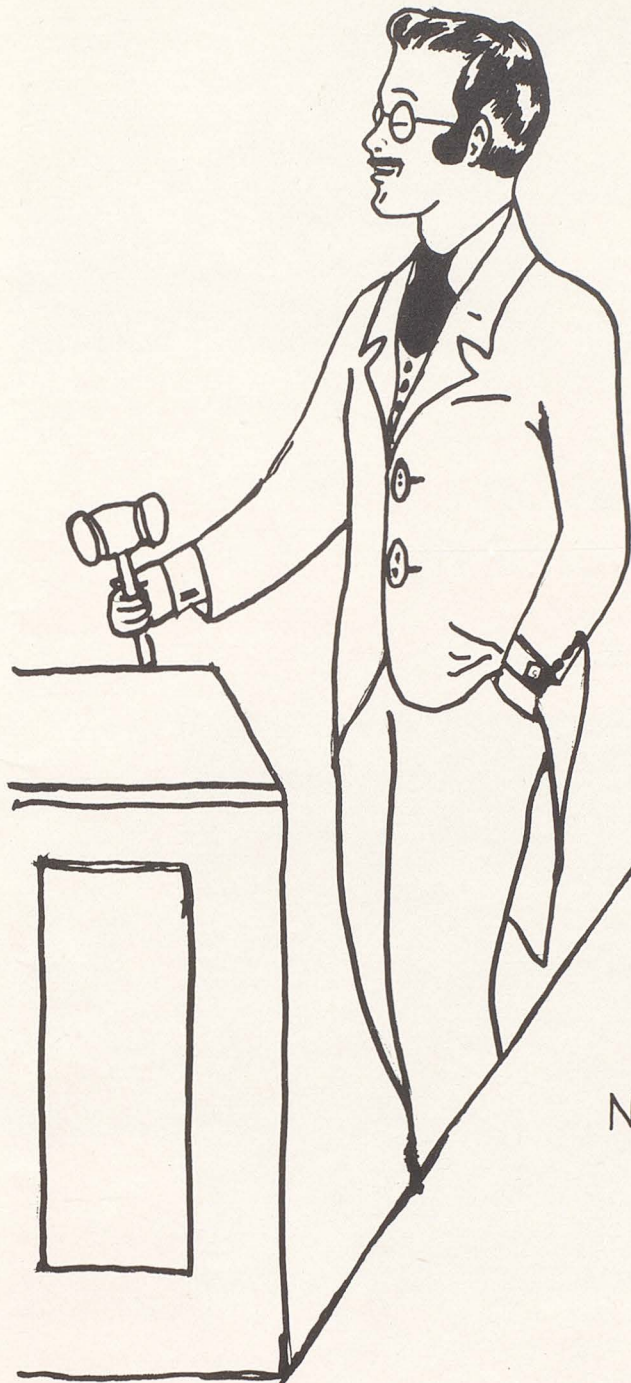
Dedication

We, the Senior class of 1955, dedicate our Black Quill to the former superintendent, William F.H.Brosvick.

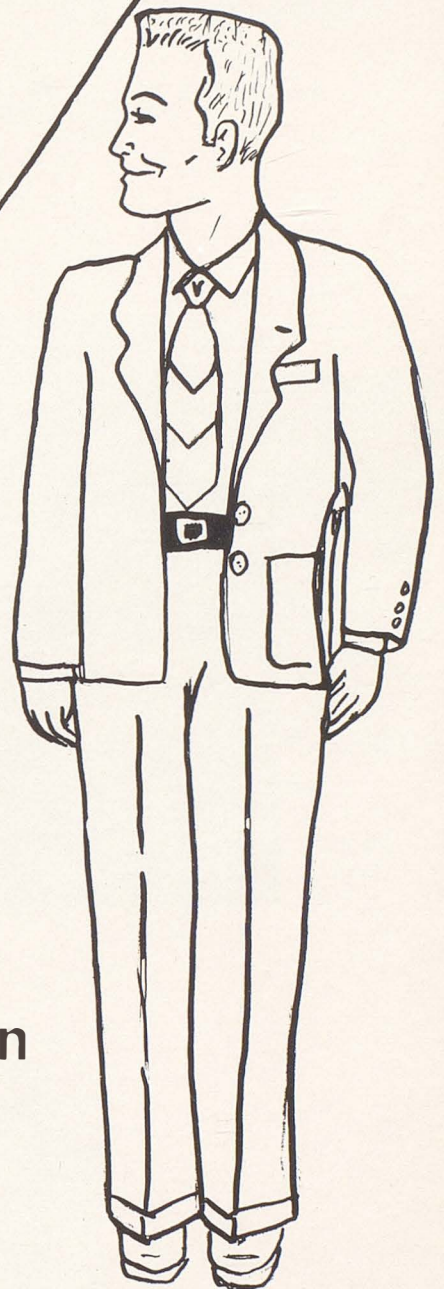
Mr. Brosvick became superintendent in 1945 and resigned in December of 1954.

We extend best wishes to Mr. Brosvick and his family in their new business venture.

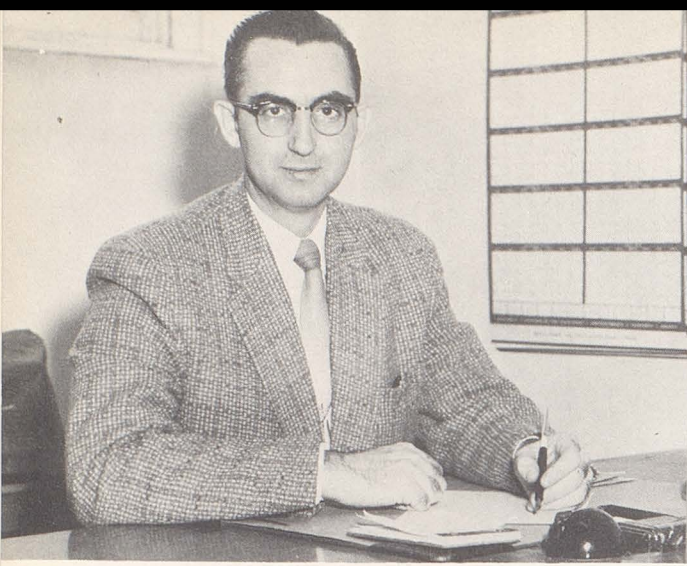

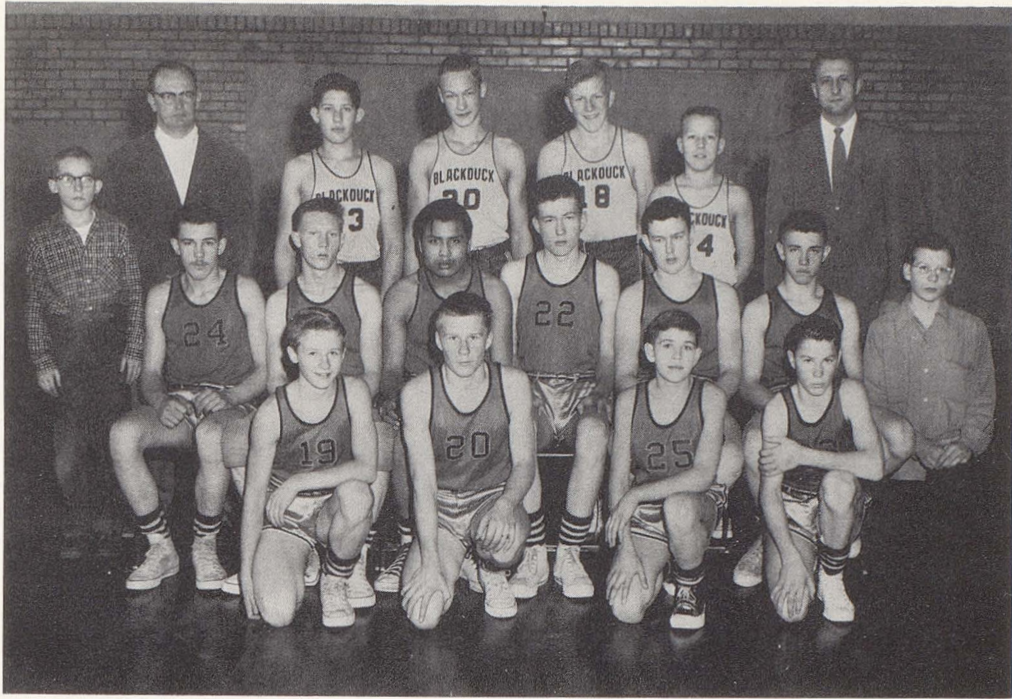
Named on the Northland Conference basketball team were three of our seniors, Wayne Austreng, Ronnie Hass, and Dave Wild.
