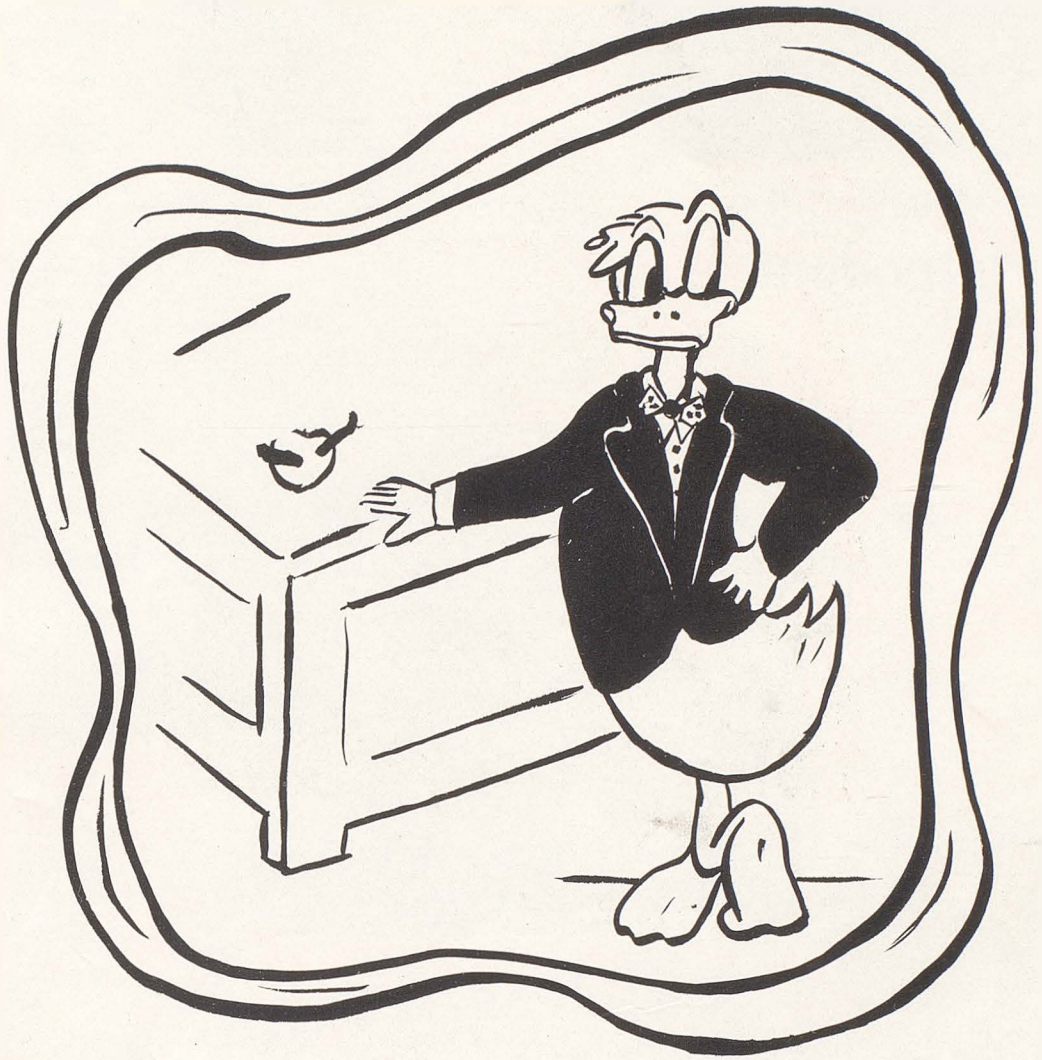




## Dedication
