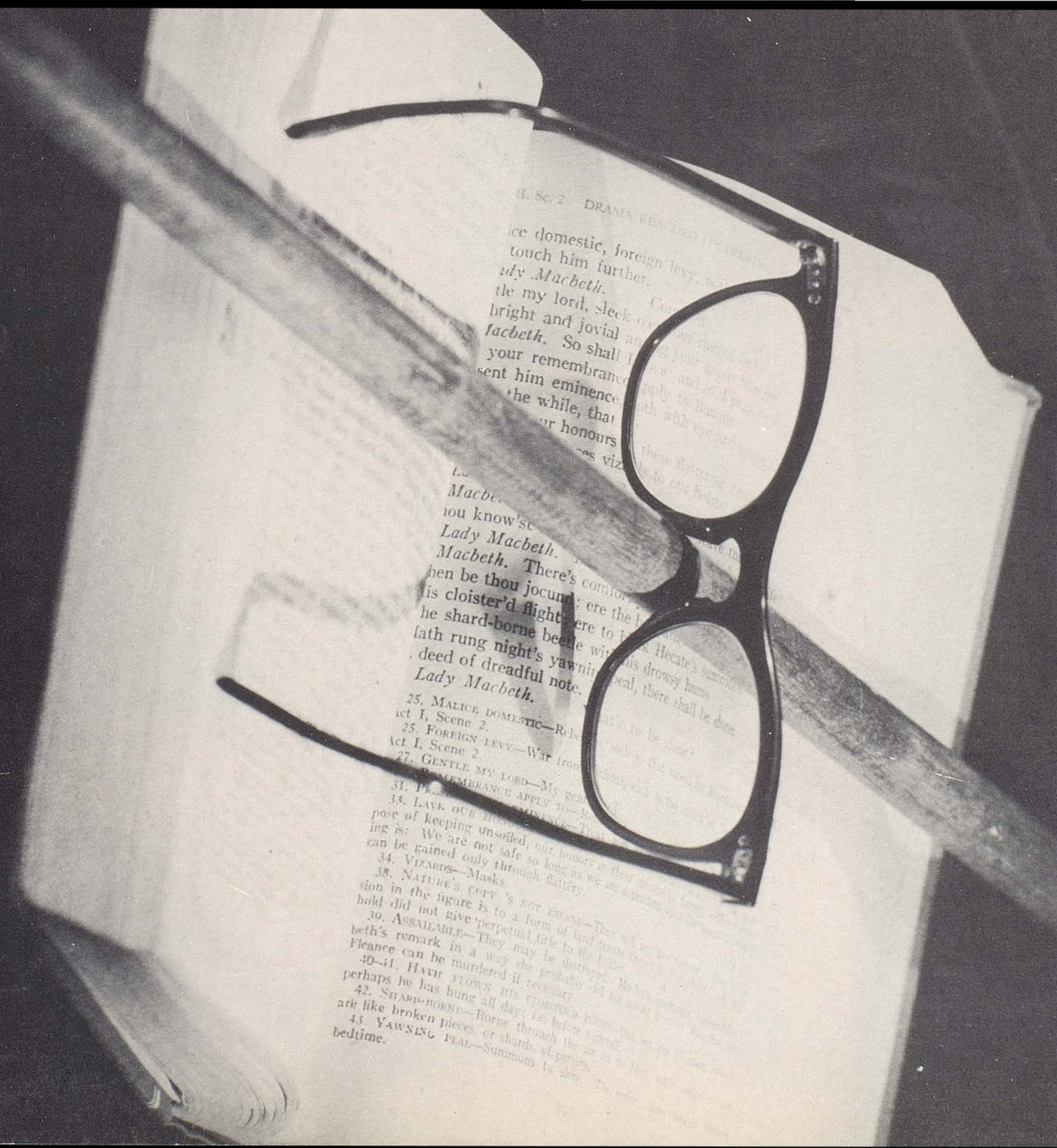




Dedication
