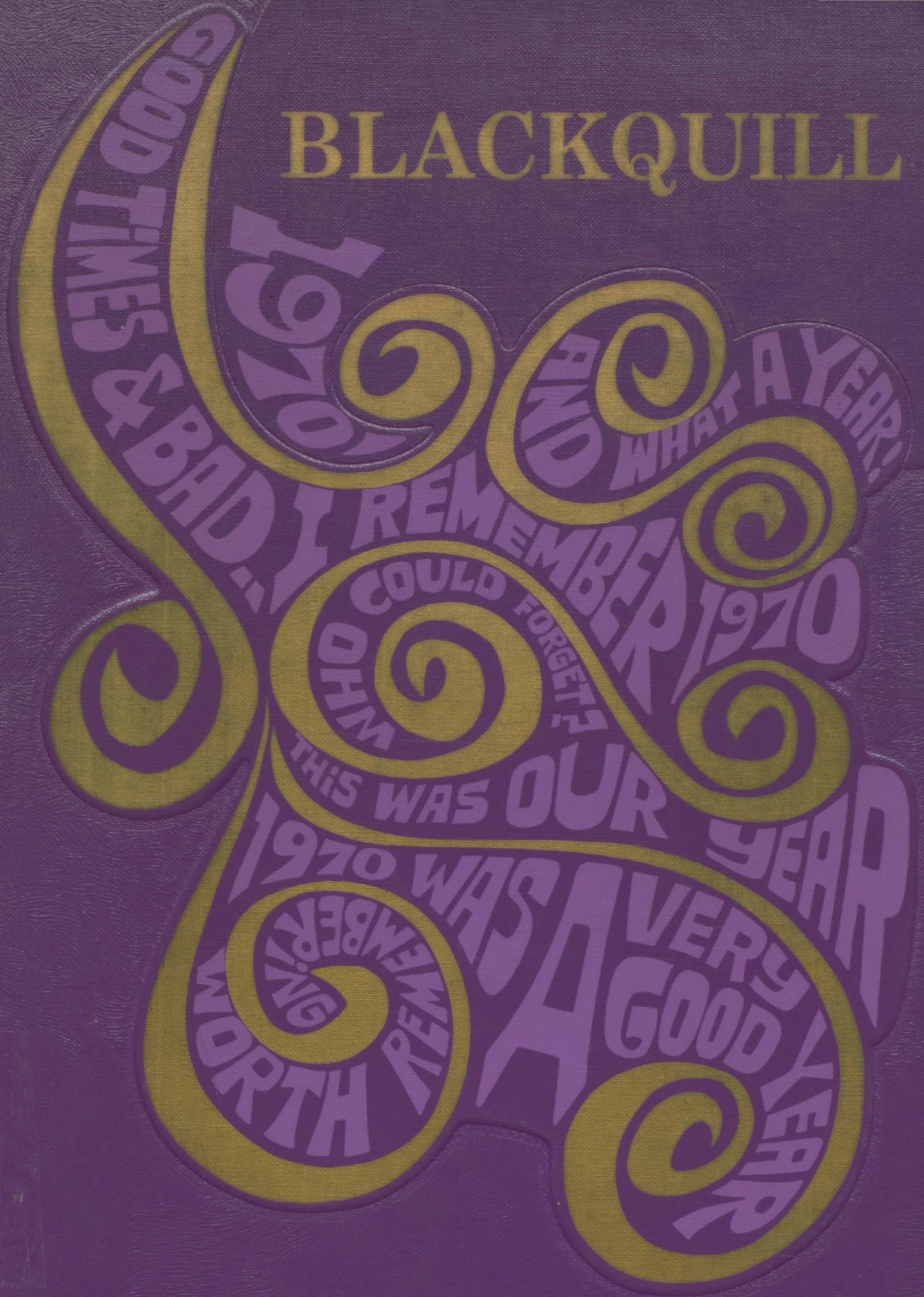

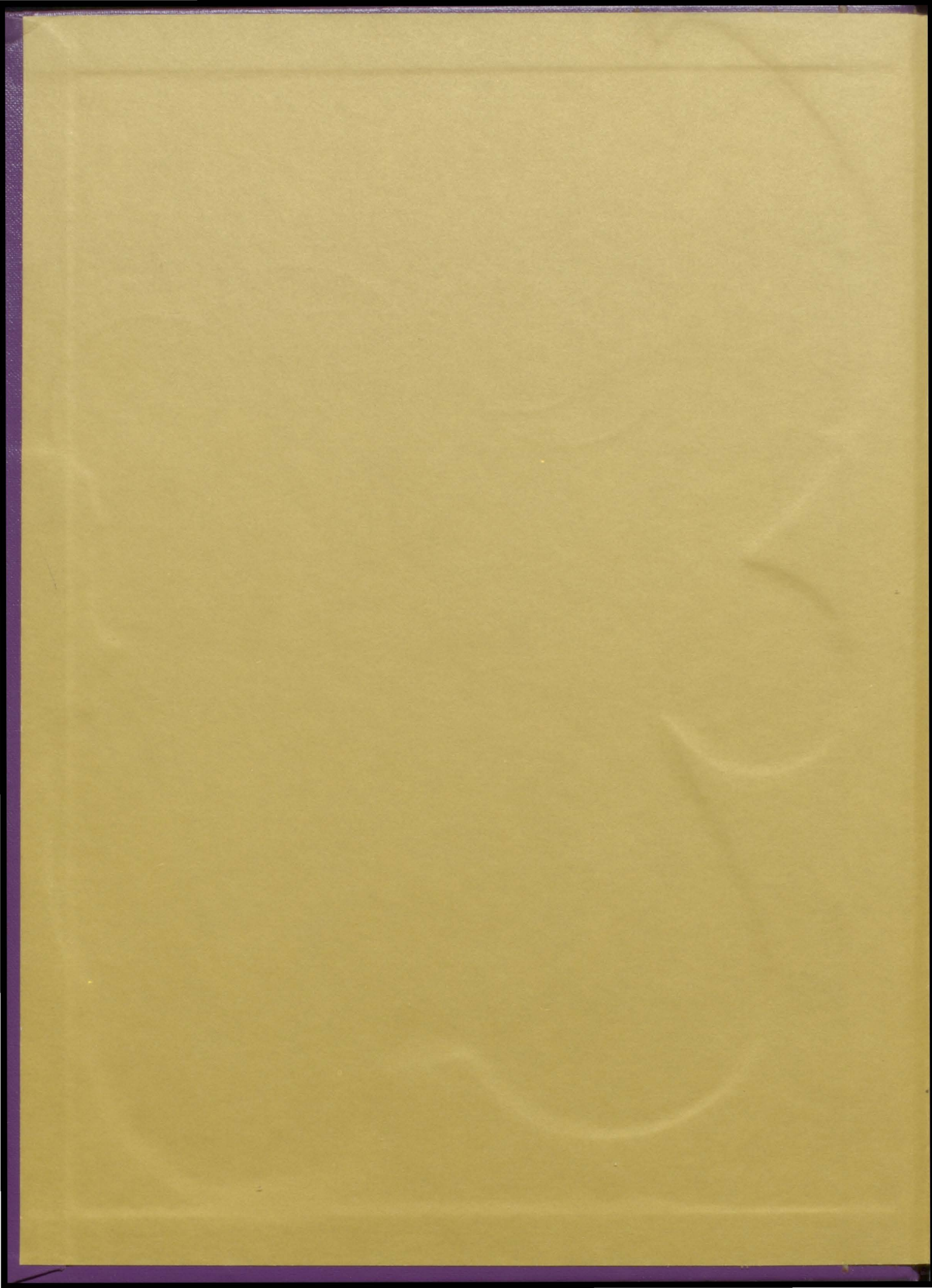

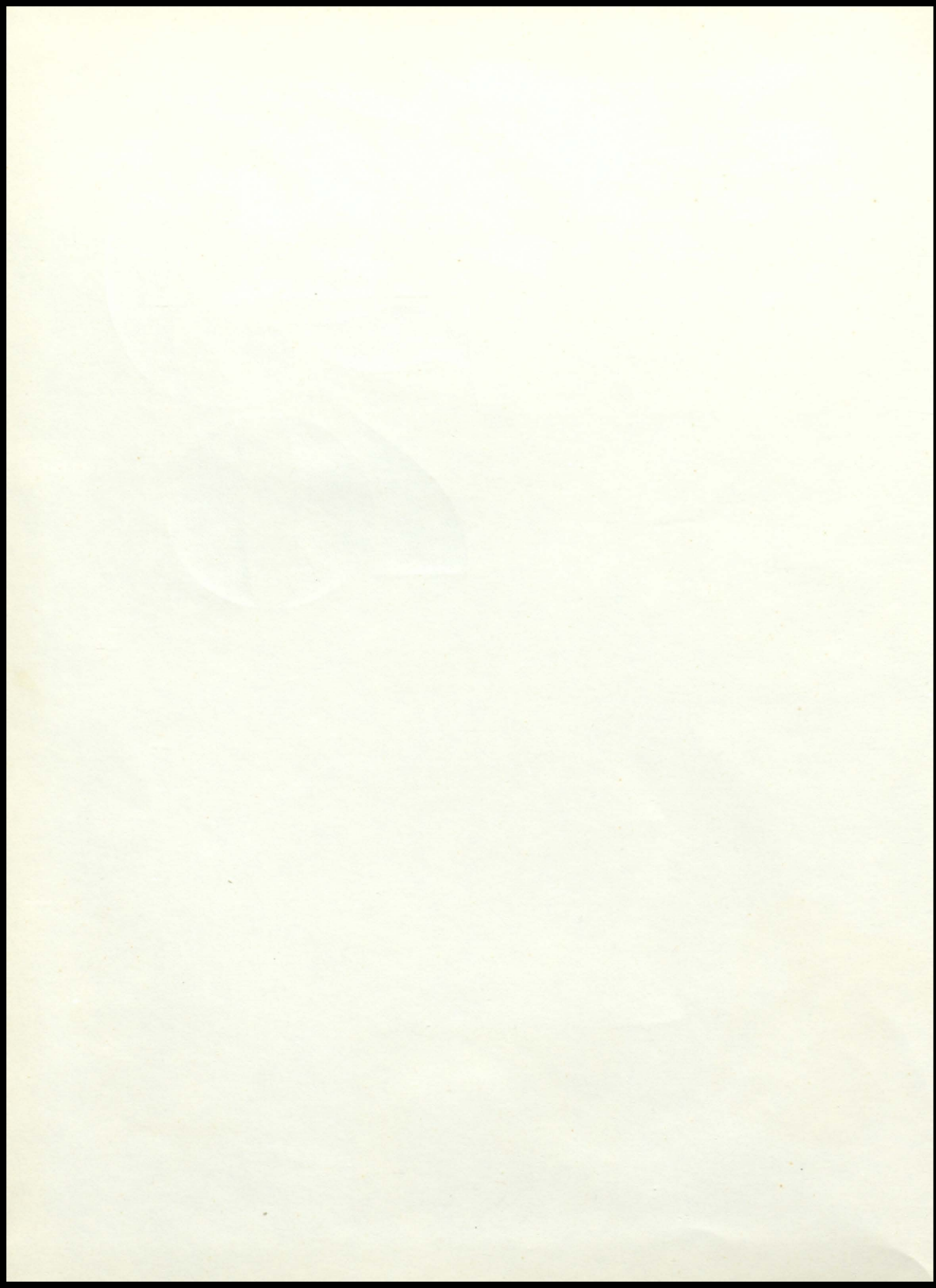

She completed her education at the University of Minnesota. Mrs. Floura has taught Home Economics for 13 years in our school.

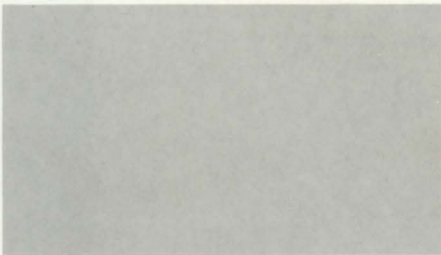
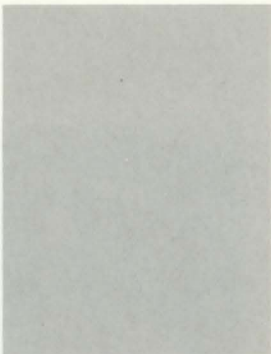
