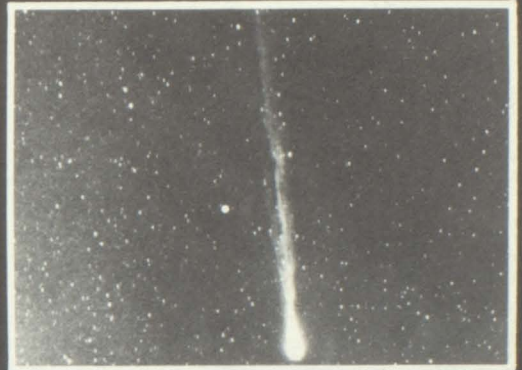

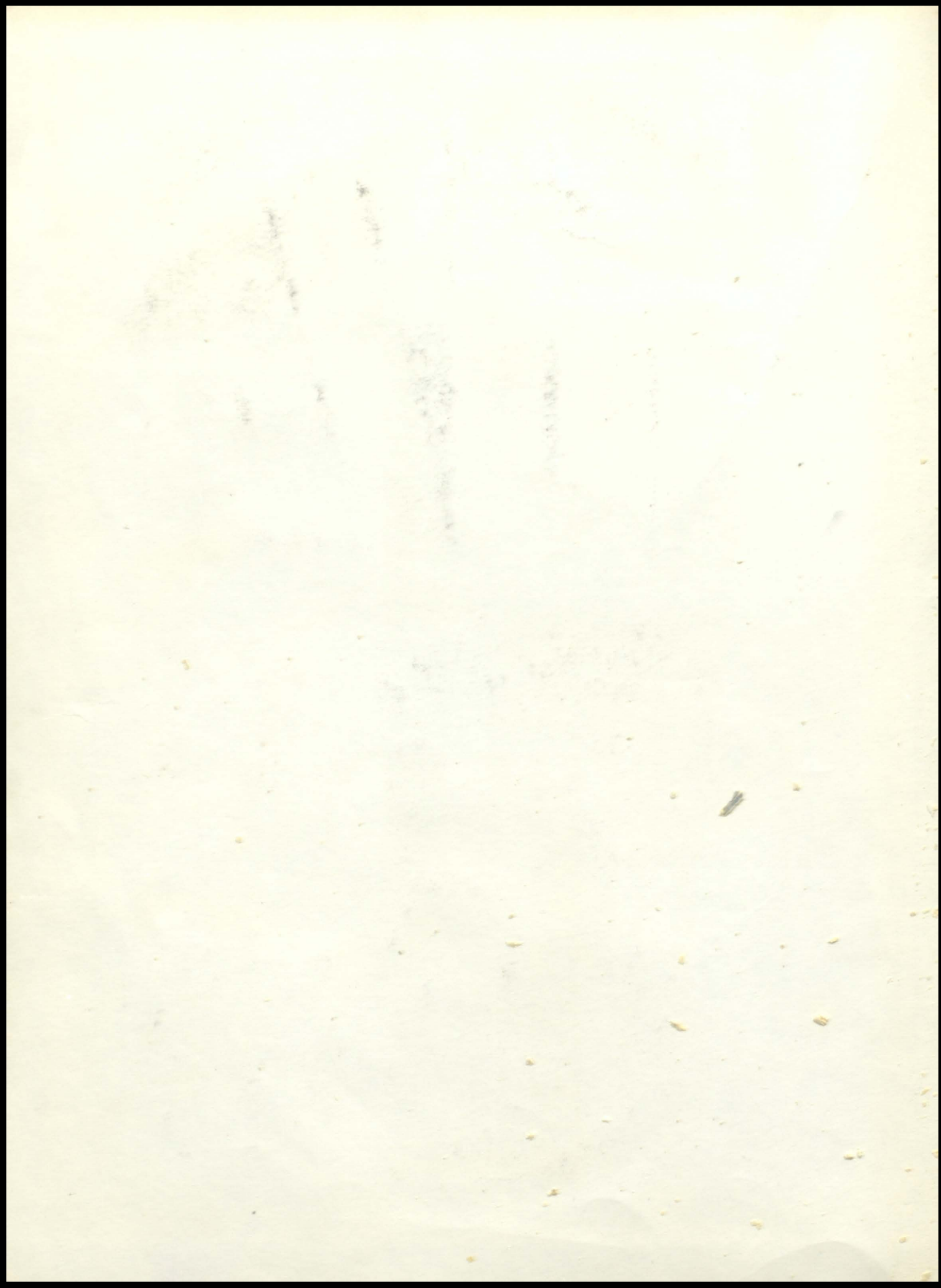

ENERGY CRISIS

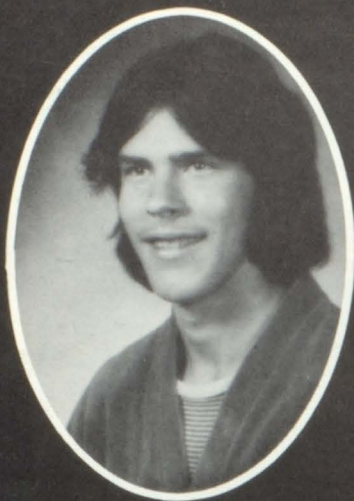

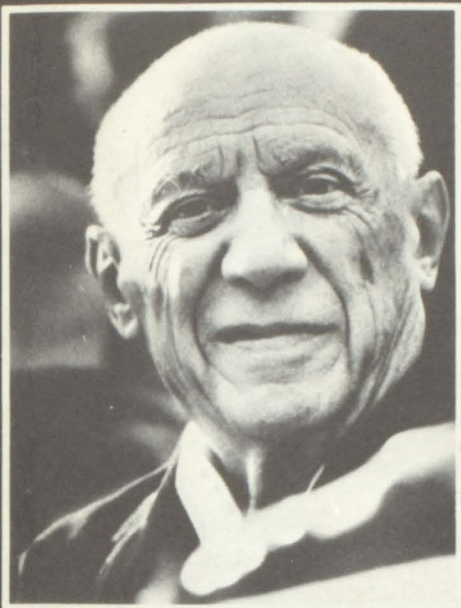
