

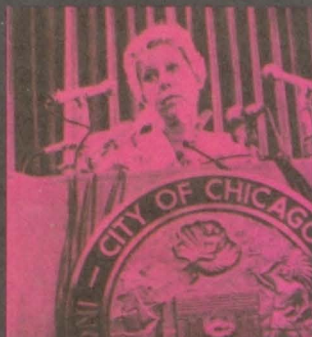

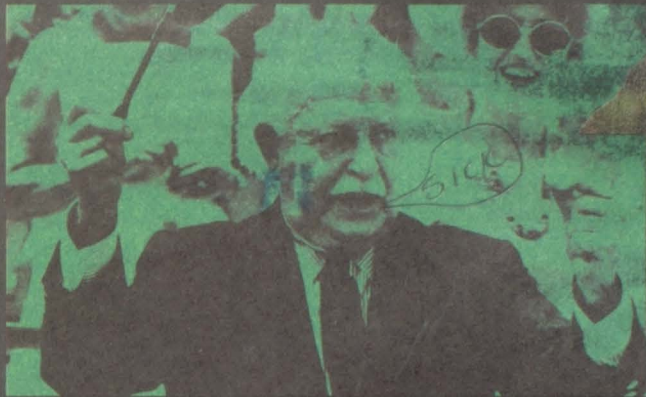

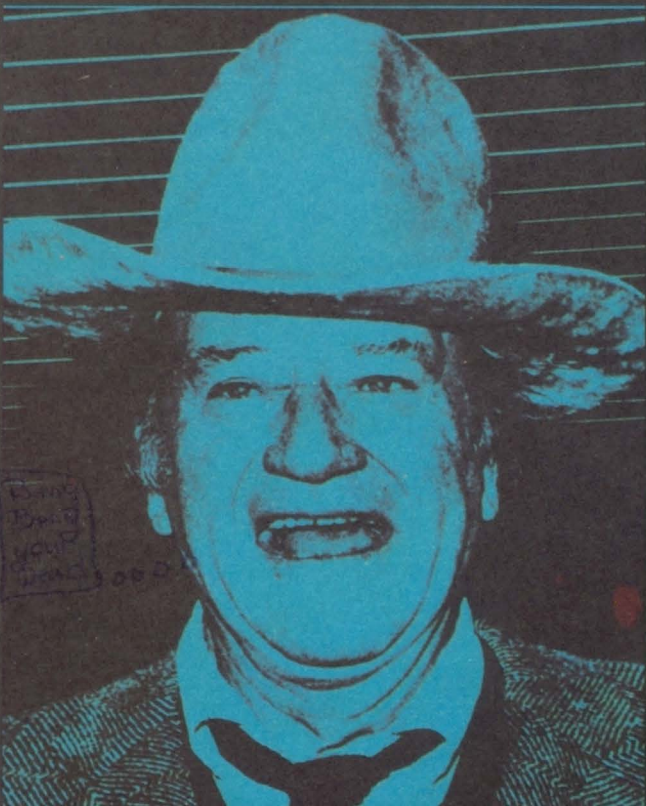

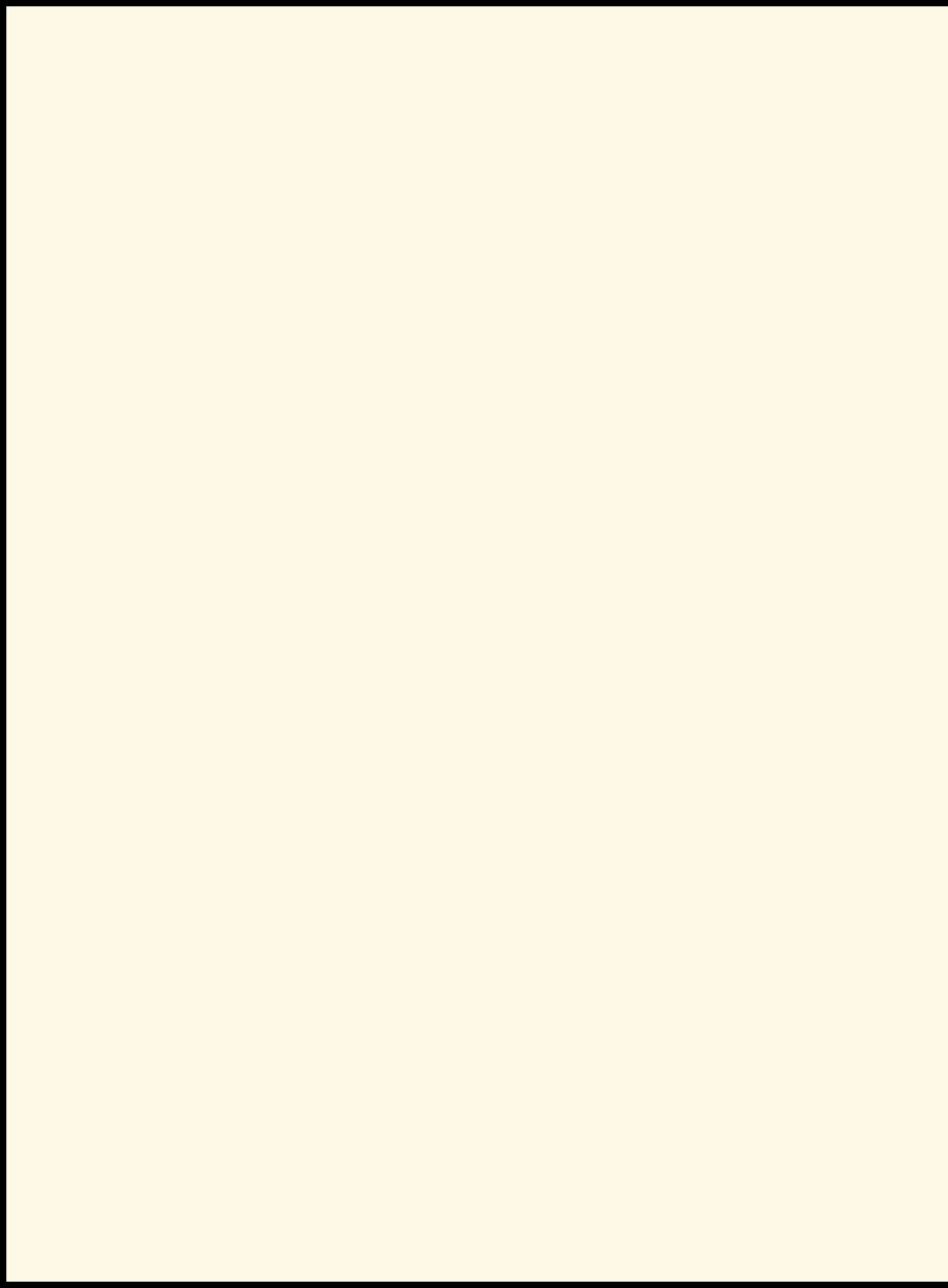

MRS. BEVERLY MOON

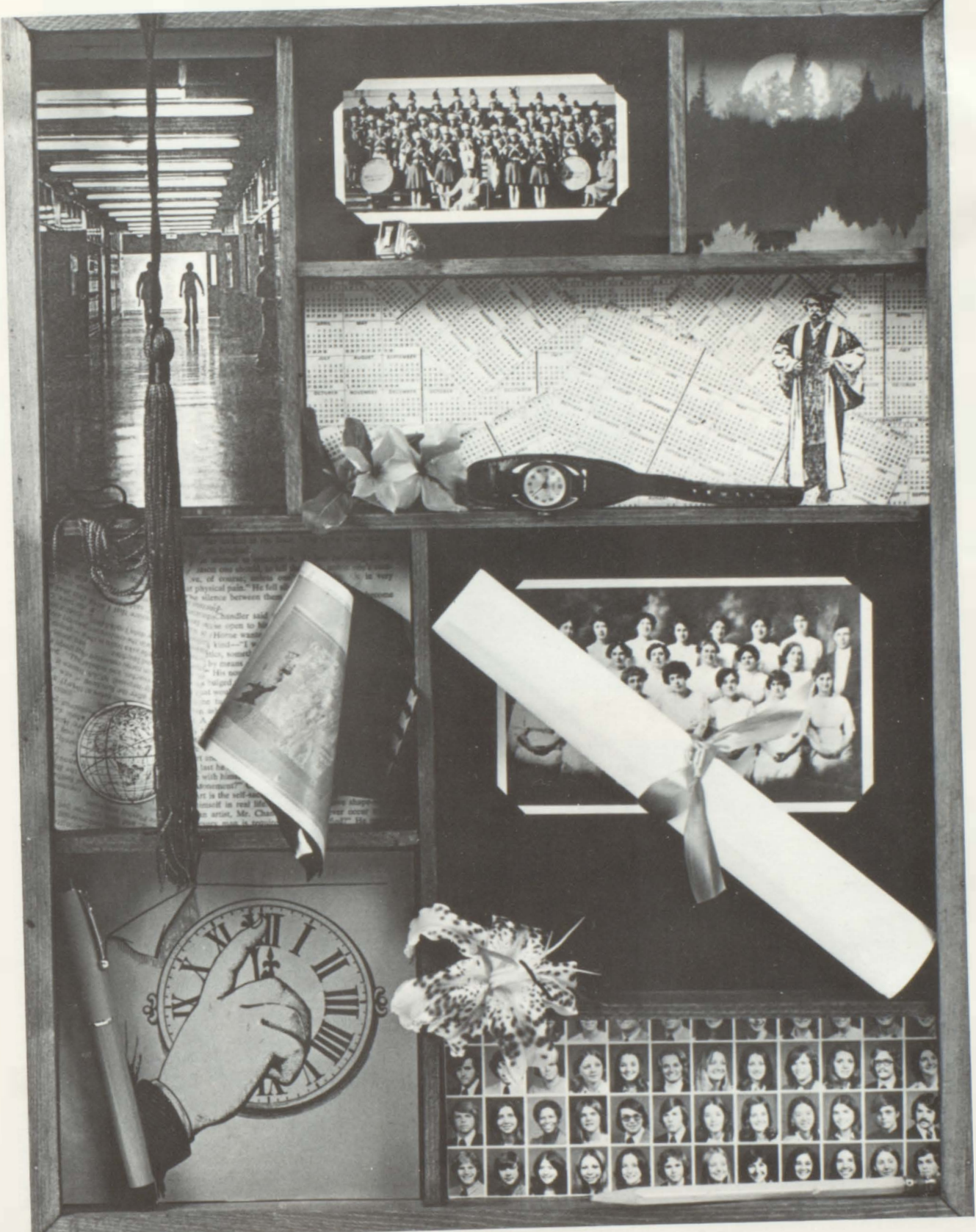

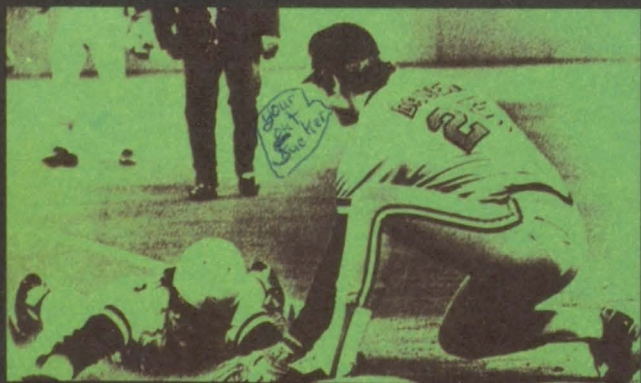

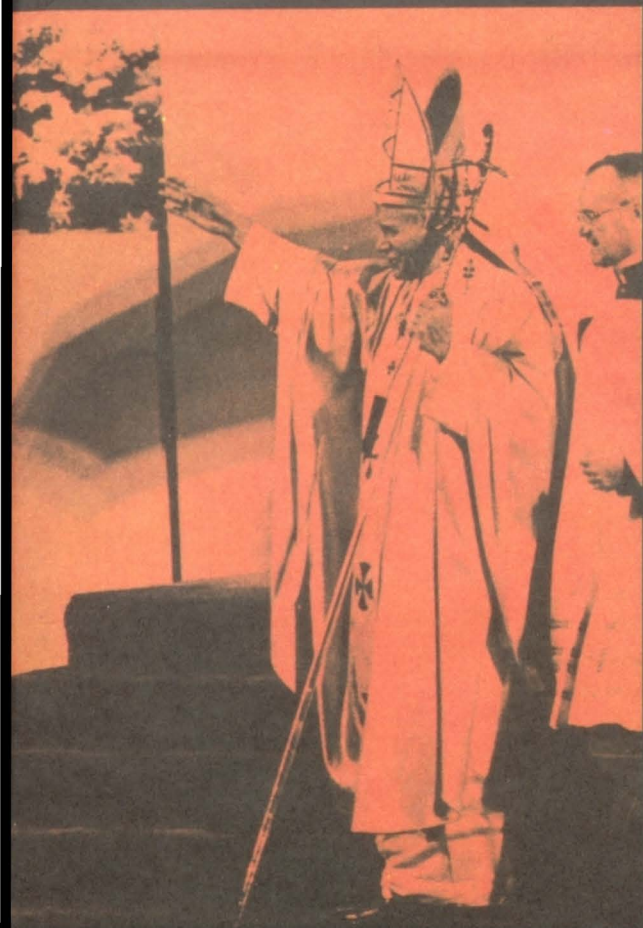

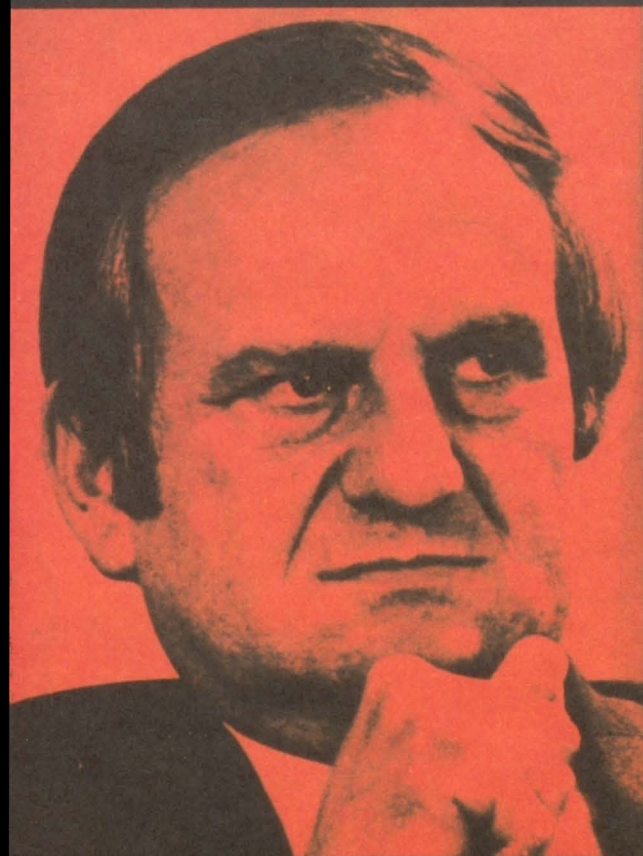
