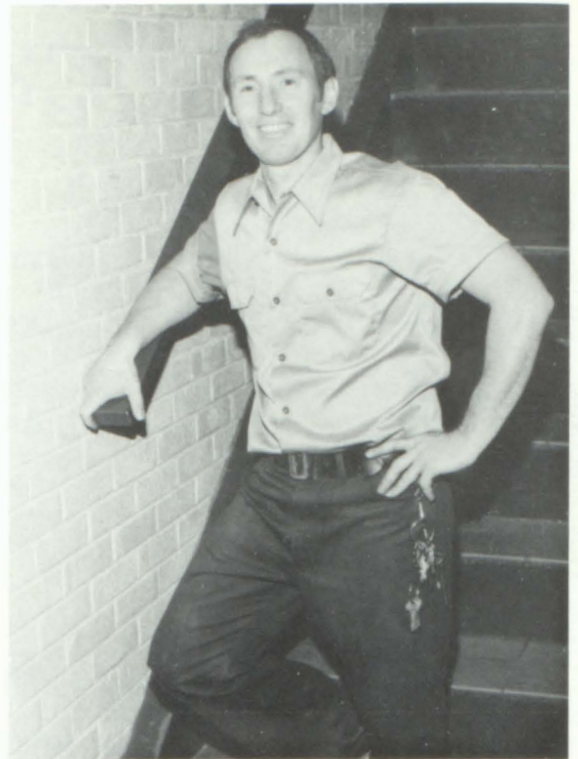
WE SALUTE . . .

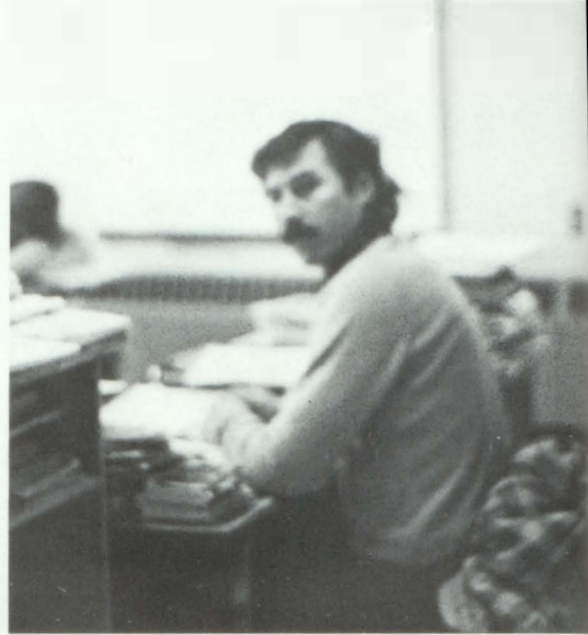
