Nina Tersia Lesiuk says she likes Blackduck a lot, even though it is colder, smaller and quieter than her hometown of Sydney, Australia.

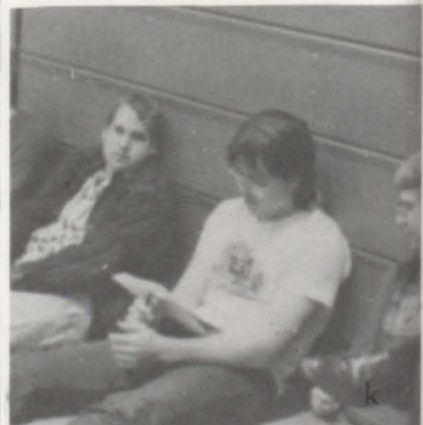
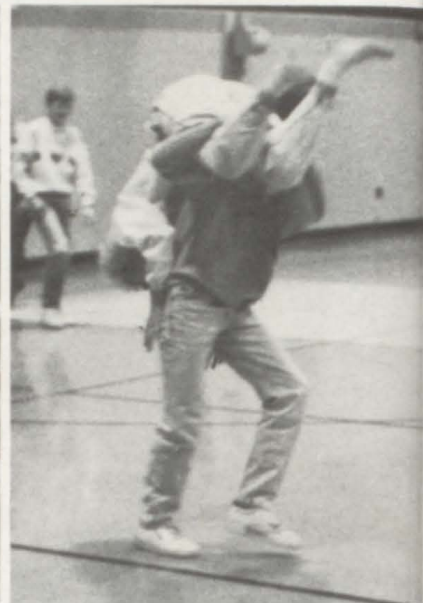
