An International Event

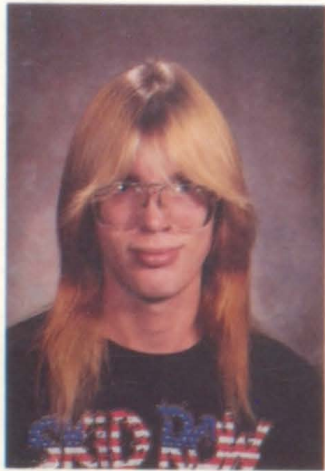

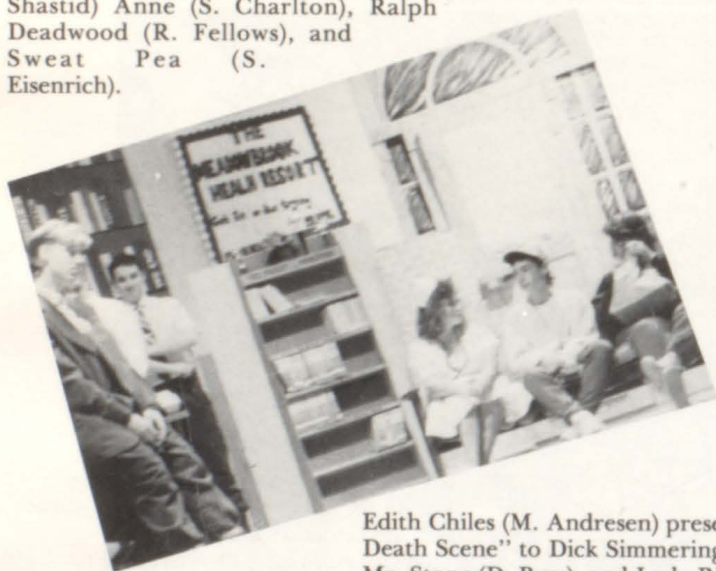

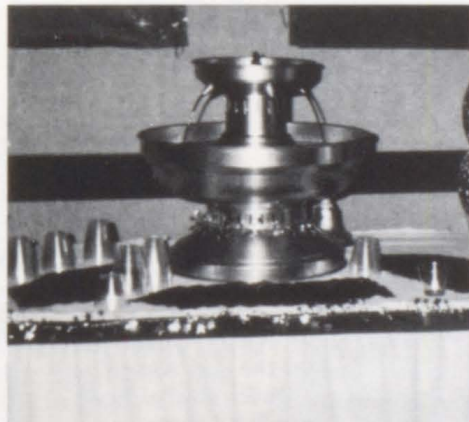

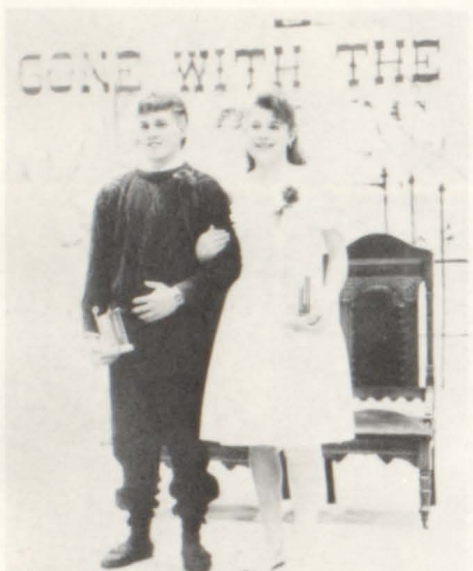

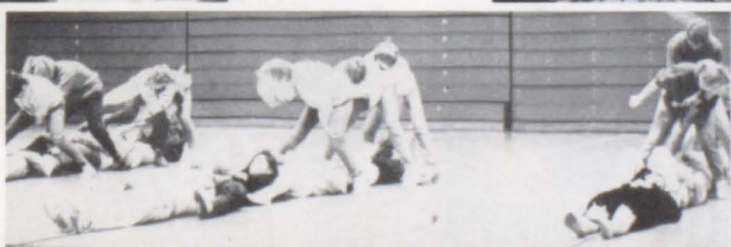
