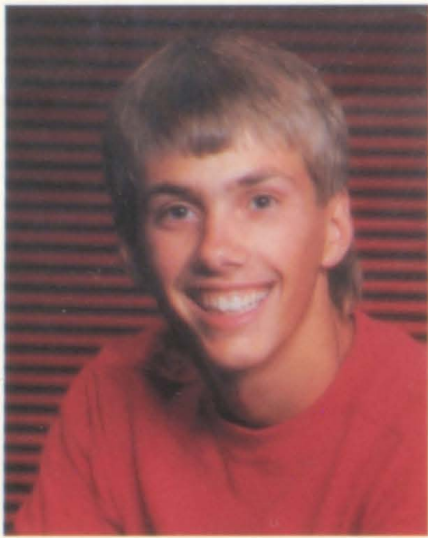
Senior Legacies

Along with his wife, Marie, Mr. Kovar has three children, Zachary, 14 years old; Jacob, 13 years old; and Greta, 11 years old. Mr. Kovar earned an English Bachelor of Arts from the University of Colorado, an English Bachelor of Science from Bemidji State University, and attended English Graduate School also at Bemidji State University. Mr. Kovar has taught for 19 years, 18 of which have been at Blackduck.

The following is from an interview with Mr. Kovar:

Why do you hope you were chosen for this Honor?

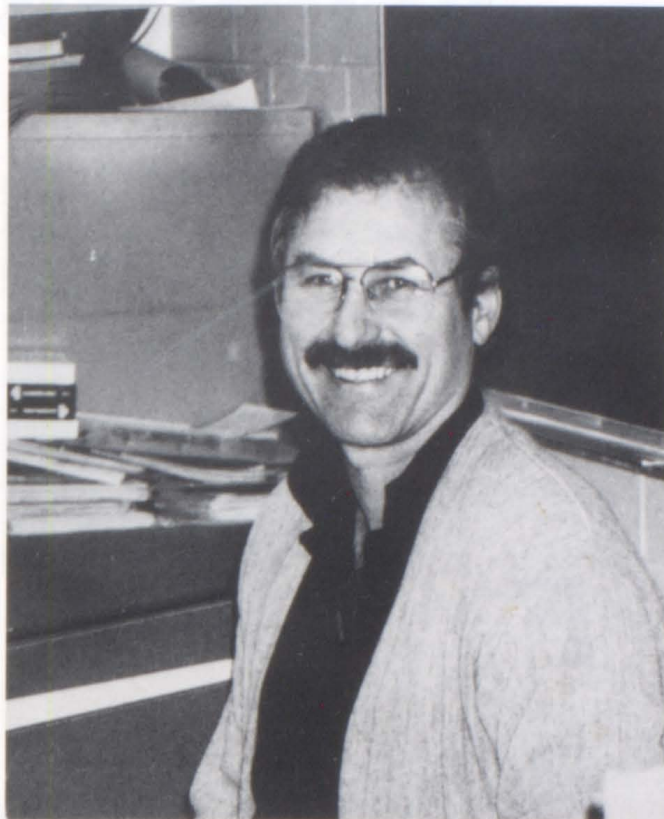
Because of my dedication to the students and the course work. I also would like to believe that I am proficient in what I do and that I have made a difference in the education and the lives of my students.

What is your educational philosophy?

I believe that all students must learn to be disciplined in whatever they do and once discipline is achieved, they will begin to perform quality work!

How important is the community and parents in the educational process?

Parental involvement is the key to success in education. Parents must become involved in the process, not necessarily by helping kids with their homework, but by setting up a structured home life that is conducive to good education. Parents must teach their children; ethics, behavior, and work ethics.



TEACHER OF THE YEAR 1991

Do you have a pet peeve in education?

People who believe education begins and ends within the doors of the school. People pay lip service to the importance of school but refuse to help assist in the changes we know are vitally important. Parents who knowingly allow their children to get by with inferior work!

What do you think education is doing right?

It is serving the needs of a greater population of students. All children regardless of ability or physical capabilities have equal access to an education. American education is truly democratic.

What would your message to students be today?

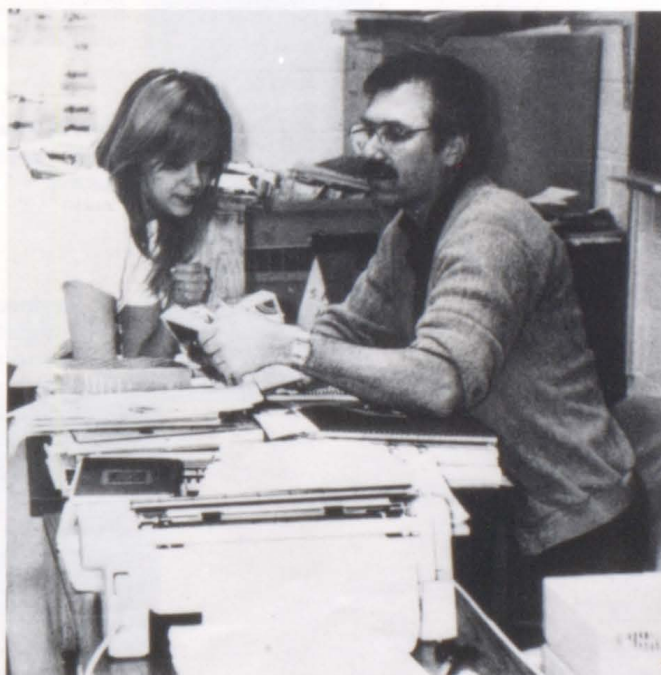
Take school more seriously. Spend more time on school work and strive for the attitude that everything you do should be done well. Education is an opportunity that too many people let slip away. When they get a little older they realize this but it's too late. Teenagers should stop trying to be adults until they have graduated.

Do you have a personal goal when you teach and if so what is it?

I want my students to be culturally literate. I expect them to be able to think and discuss about what they have read. I also expect students to learn responsibility for their actions and pride in their work.

Is there anything else you would like to mention?

Today the entire education system is undergoing a dramatic structural change. I hate to say it but I believe student performance will not improve regardless of the change or money pumped into the system until parents demand more from their children and gain control over their lives. Kids need more structure and well defined ethics which is lacking in society today. Until attitudes and behaviors change, test scores will continue their downward spiral.

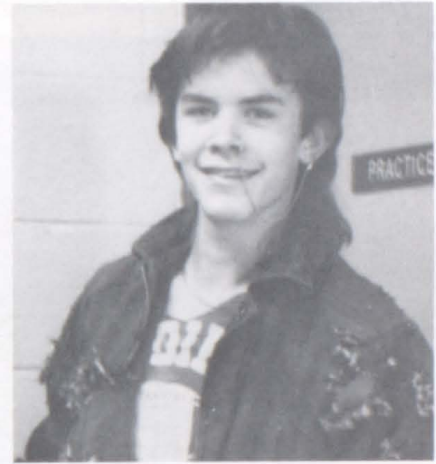
