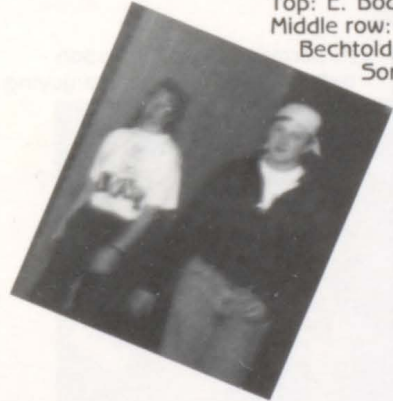

What is your Educational philosophy?

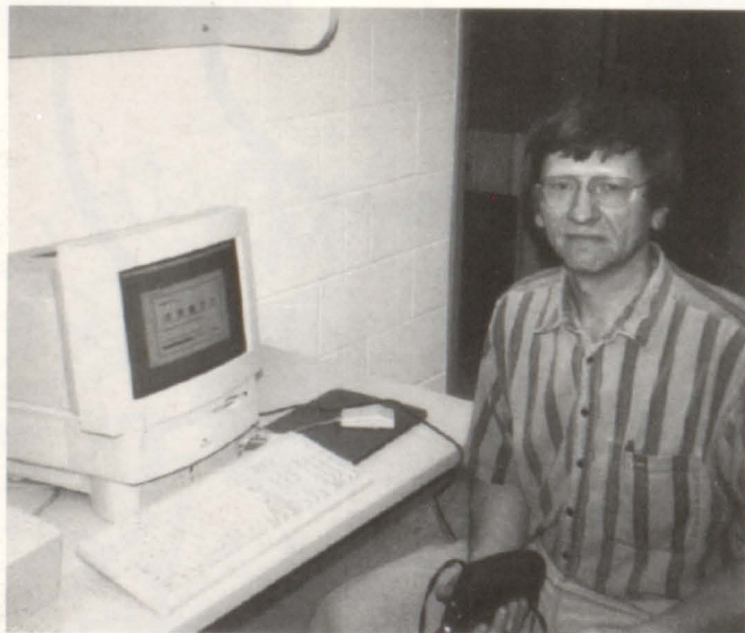
Kids should be doing activities, observations, and experiments; where they actually discover the lesson involved.
