In ten years Greta Kovar will be in a high paying legal position, trying to shut down Briana's Nudist Colony without entering the premises.

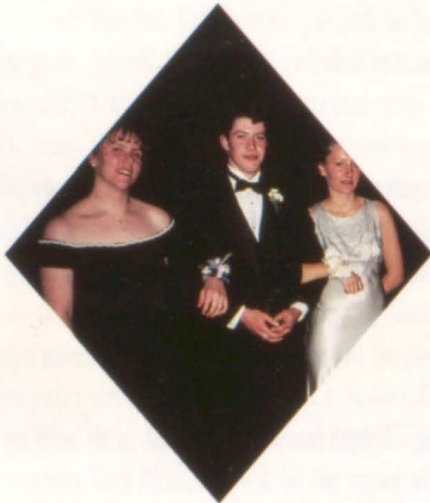
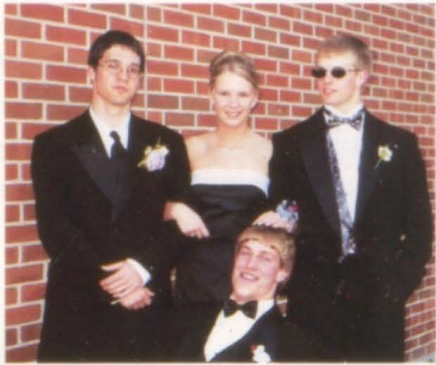

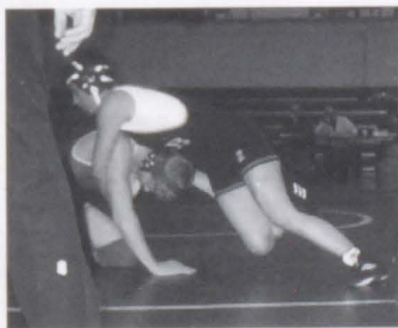

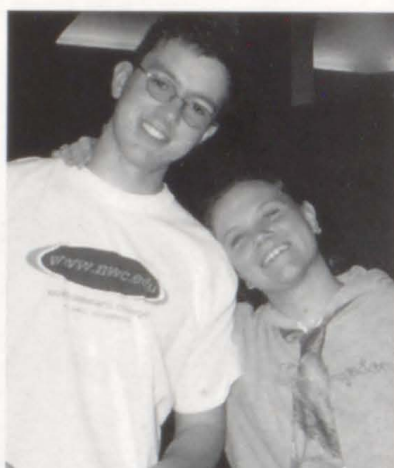
