I couldn't believe that I was going to live a real life with people I had never met before, and be friends with teenagers that don't know my native language. I was scared about all these things, since I knew about the United States only from T.V., radio, and magazines. I couldn't imagine it until I realized I was already in my host family. A big thing for me was to leave my family, and other people I know and love in Russia.

I learned a lot, and not only from school. I learned from the people that I lived with, my new friends, and from the life I lived here. I learned that you can't judge another country based only on what you know from the T.V. or radio, or from movies or songs. If you want to know about another culture and the people who have lived inside this culture, then you have to be one of them. And I want to say a big thanks to my host family, Wanda and Curtis Anderson. Thanks for being such a great parents and good teachers. Thank you for helping me and for making me feel like your own child.

I also want to say thank you to my own family, for giving me this chance, for supporting me and my decisions, for being with me even when we were so far away from each other.

The main thing I have found out from this experience is to learn for myself that people are mostly the same all over. They may have different traditions, languages, food, and other things they are used to - but each one is still a person, good or bad, rich or poor, kid or adult. If I had a problem, my host parents always were ready to help. When I was lonely, my American friends were there for me.

I tried to try. I learned to try. And I learned to learn.

It has been a great experience to be here and I am sure it will help me to make my future better. It has made me believe that I can be what I want to be. I just have to do my best and try hard.

I know that this first step in real life is only the beginning of my future and I am so glad that my beginning has been so exciting, new, and cool!

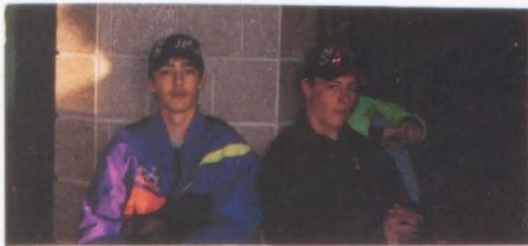
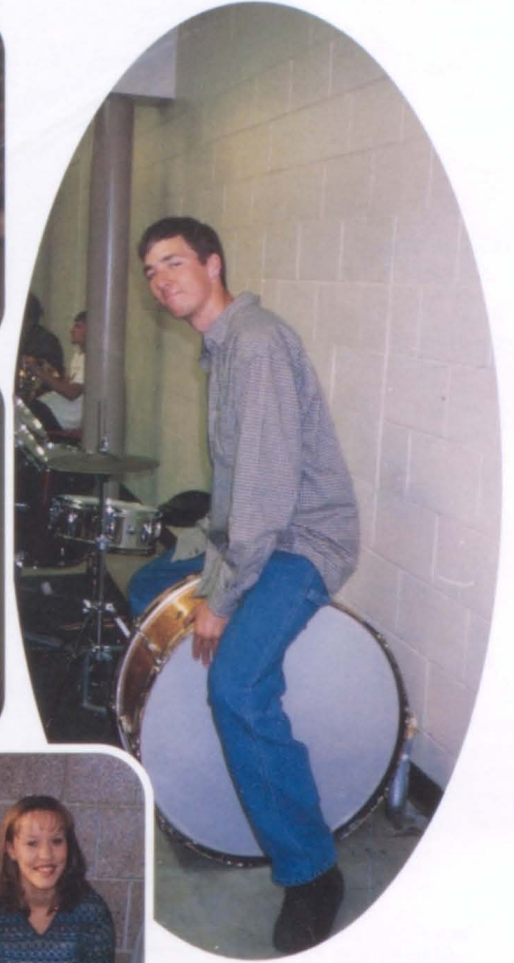

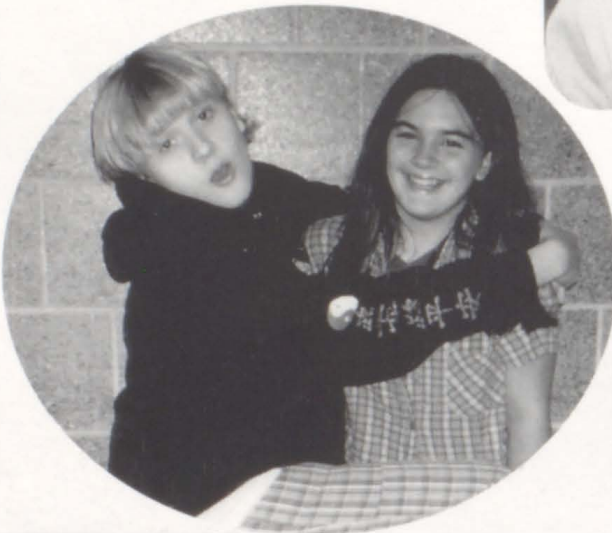
