KIP SOLBERG will be serving his tenth year in the Navy and going to college to become a mechanic and/or nuclear technician while living the good life.

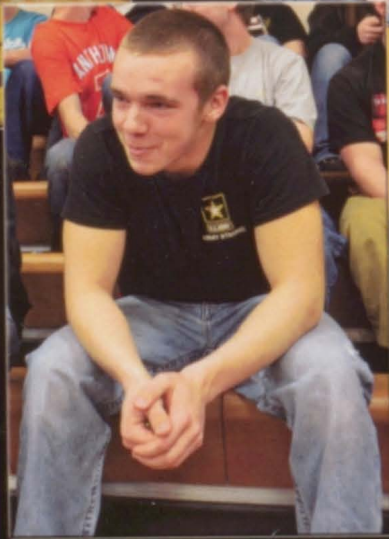
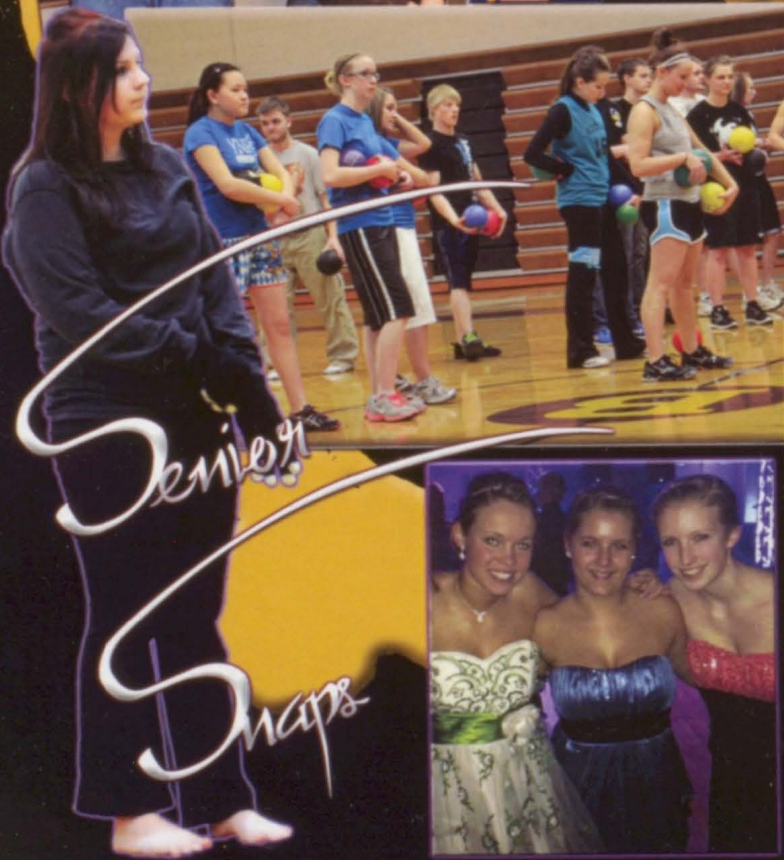
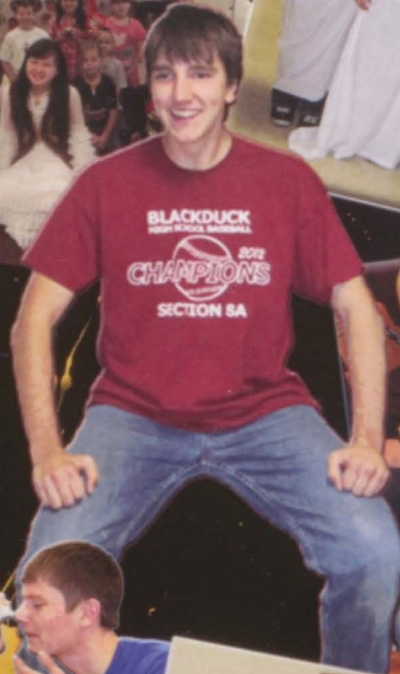
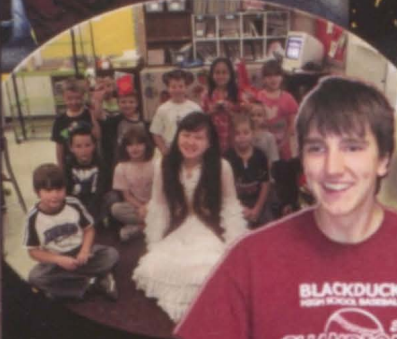
