Alex Tindell will be living in a cardboard box in Las Vegas trying to get back the money she lost while playing slots.

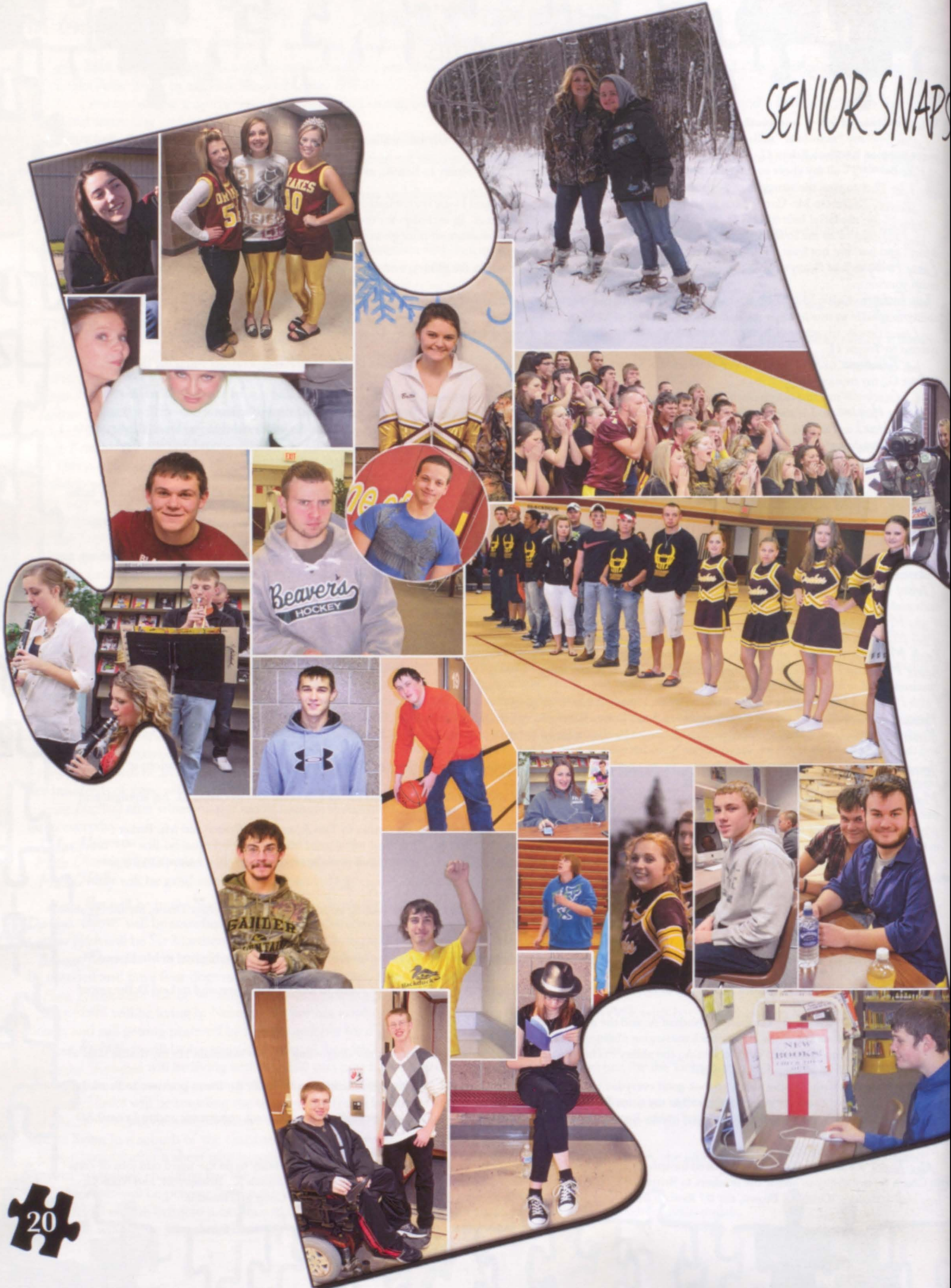
