## **2021 Blackduck Winter Sports Press Release**

The MN State High School League has announced that a limited number of people will be allowed into competitions. *Blackduck High School is allowing two (2) adult spectators per student-athlete to attend home events.*

- Each member of the team will be allowed to have TWO adult spectators. **TWO PEOPLE ONLY. THE ONLY EXCEPTION IS IF YOU HAVE A YOUNGER CHILD THAT CAN'T STAY HOME ALONE OR A SPLIT FAMILY. PLEASE MAKE CONTACT WITH THE ACTIVITIES DIRECTOR IN ADVANCE IF THIS APPLIES.**
  - Names and phone numbers will be collected in advance from the coaches to give to the AD. This is being done in case notifications have to be made if an individual develops COVID-19. (The visiting team's AD will email Blackduck's AD a list of spectators' names/phone numbers by noon of game day and a game worker will take names and phone numbers at the door.)
  - Varsity & JV spectators must enter Door #3 located on the West side of the building. Jr. High games will be played in the Elementary Gym, therefore the approved spectators must enter Door #11 on the back side of the Elementary School to watch those games. Spectators will NOT be allowed to go between gyms and watch other games.
- Masks must be worn, properly covering mouth and nose, at all times in the building.
- Immediately after the game, fans are asked to leave and not congregate on the floor or hallways.
- Spectators must be separated by at least 6 feet between households/families.
- NO ADMISSION CHARGED** for games.
- Restrooms WILL BE available.
- Visiting team WILL HAVE a locker room provided.
- There will be a concessions stand, per MDH and MSHSL guidelines.
