

4-H Summer Program Offerings

Dear Program Partner,

As the school year winds down, and you ramp up for summer, remember that 4-H is here to help and has many great program opportunities for you to choose from.

2021 4-H summer program opportunities

Each 4-H program will provide hands-on learning related to the topic, and through interactive games and discussions youth will develop social and emotional skills. All programs are led by Extension Educators like myself.

There are multi ways to partner with 4-H this summer:

- **4-H Virtual Summer Day Camps-** These learning opportunities are three hours in length and offered virtually via Zoom on Thursdays from 1-4pm. These virtual learning opportunities will start June 10 and end July 27.
- **4-H Virtual Summer Learning Opportunities-** These learning opportunities are one hour in length and offered virtually via Zoom Monday through Thursday. There are two sessions to choose from a morning session from 10am-11am and an afternoon session from 1pm -2pm. These virtual learning opportunities will start on June 21 and end August 6.
- **4-H On Demand Resource Library-** This is a collection of pre-recorded programs that you facilitate with your group when it works for you. Programs have between 3-5 sessions and last around 45min. There are a wide variety of offerings and the catalog is always expanding. Those individuals who will be helping to facilitate these sessions take a one hour training before they gain access to use the library.
- **4-H Healthy Sprouts-** a 4-H program that offers lessons in gardening, STEM, healthy eating and agriculture career exploration. Youth learn through a variety of "hands on" activities that are applied as they tend their own gardens. 4-H Healthy Sprouts program meets weekly, starting the first week of June, and ends with a celebration during the last week of August. You can choose to attend one of the weekly sessions being offered: Tuesday at 1:00pm or Thursday at 10:00am.
