

Safe Return to In-Person Learning 2021-2022

The Blackduck Public School will continue to offer in-person learning to all students, as it did for the entire 2020-2021 school year. We will continue our efforts to maintain the health and safety of students and staff for the 2021-2022 school year.

The Blackduck School District shall continue efforts to keep a high standard of safety and cleanliness to ensure we are able to provide in-person learning for all of our students into the foreseeable future.

These standards currently include:

1. Face Coverings - **All staff, students, and visitors within Independent School District #32 buildings are not required to wear a mask, regardless of vaccination status. Individuals may voluntarily wear a mask if they so choose.** It is strongly encouraged that individuals follow the strategies of physical distancing, handwashing and respiratory etiquette, cleaning and disinfection and staying home when sick.
2. Reporting - The School Nurse will continue to perform any required reporting processes.
3. Transportation - Masking **is required** on public transportation, which includes school buses, this is under the regulations of the Transportation Security Administration (TSA). See information below.

Blackduck public schools does **NOT** plan on implementing any restrictions that are not **mandated** by the federal or state government.
